

Rules and Eligibility

Ages & Divisions — The tournament is open to all Ohio State University students and alumni. The field is limited to 144 golfers. Each team is composed of a two-person scramble, divided into either a student division or an alumni division. Players must be 18 years of age or older.

Format—The qualifier tournament will be a two-person scramble with a shotgun start at Noon. Greens fees and carts are included in the entry fee. Any ties in the student or alumni divisions will be determined by a play-off.

Rules—The qualifier tournament will be conducted under USGA Rules of Golf. Local rules will be provided as needed.
